Keep the instructions at a location so that they are always accessible to all users.

Always pass on the carsound system to third parties together with these instructions.

In addition, observe the instructions of the devices used in conjunction with this car sound system.

#### **Road safety**

Observe the following notes about road safety:

Use this device in such a way that you can always safely control your vehicle. As the driver, you should not use applications that will distract you from driving.

Follow the driving recommendations during the route guidance only if you are not violating any traffic regulations! Traffic signs and traffic regulations always have priority over driving recommendations. Always listen at a moderate volume to protect your hearing and to be able to hear acoustic warning signals (e.g., police sirens). During mute phases (e.g., when changing the audio source), changing the volume is not audible. Do not increase the volume during this mute phase.

#### **General safety notes**

Observe the following note to protect yourself against injuries:

Use as directed.

As with all Capacitive Touchscreens, if your fingers are wet or sweaty, it will not function properly.

Repairs and installation, if necessary, should be performed by a specialist.

#### **Installation instructions**

It is recommended to only have this unit installed by a professional who specializes in vehicle audio system installations. Not all auto electricians have the expertise to install such units.

This car sound system is intended for installation and operation in a vehicle with 12V DC and must be installed in a 2-DIN slot.

#### Cleaning notes

Solvents, cleaning and scouring agents as well as dashboard spray and plastics care product may contain ingredients that will damage the surface of this unit.

 $Use only a dry or slightly moist ened cloth for cleaning the {\it car} sound {\it system}.$ 



### Placing the device in operation

### Switching on/off with the POWER button

Forswitch-on, press the Ubutton.

For switch-off, hold the  $\circlearrowleft$  button pressed for more than 2 seconds.

### Adjusting the volume

You can adjust the volume in steps from 0 (off) to 40 (maximum).

Pressthebutton+toraise volume and – button to lower the volume.

### **Apple CarPlay**

CarPlay is a smarter, safer way to use your iPhone in the car. CarPlay takes the things you want to do with your iPhone while driving and puts them right on your car's built-in display.

You can get directions, make calls, send, and receive messages, and listen to audiobooks and music, all in away that allows you to stay focused on the road.

NOTE: Apple CarPlay usage is limited while driving. Functions, content, and usability is determined by the App provider(s).

Controls will vary with each App that is available for CarPlay. For more details visit:


When in doubt, park the vehicle and engage the parking brake first before performing the function(s).

#### How to enter CarPlay mode

Establish Bluetooth connection between the car unit and your iPhone (refer to the previous chapter "Bluetooth mode"). Agree using CarPlay with the car device. Please turn off the Wi-Fi function in the settings menu of the car unit before connecting your phone via Bluetooth.

1. To exit CarPlay mode, touch the return button (3) on the front panel.

 $To \ disconnect \ CarPlay, select \ [\textbf{Connections}] \ on \ the \ main \ menu, and \ deselect \ the \ options \ right to \ the \ iPhone.$ 



#### Siri

Press and hold Apple Home key on car product screen or Side Button on iPhone for using Siri voice assistant, such as issuing a call, playing music, opening the map and other voice commands.

When iPhone is connected, enable Siri by steering wheel control.

This function is only available on cars equipped with the equivalent key.

Control with "Hey, Siri".

#### **CarPlay Display Setup**

You can add, remove, or arrange the order of the apps on the CarPlay screen of the unit.

On your iPhone, go to Settings  $\rightarrow$  General  $\rightarrow$  CarPlay, select this unit's name from the device list. Then select customize to access the CarPlay Apps.

Touch and drag an app (  $\equiv$  ) to change the order of an app. Touch  $\bigcirc$  or  $\bigcirc$  to remove or add Apps. Only Apps with these symbols can be removed or added.

To disable Apps or restrict Apps from being used in CarPlay mode- on your iPhone, go to Settings  $\rightarrow$  Screen Time  $\rightarrow$  Contents & Privacy Restrictions  $\rightarrow$  Allowed Apps  $\rightarrow$  CarPlay.

NOTE: The units Bluetooth will turn OFF automatically when CarPlay is in use.

Handsfree phone functionality will be via CarPlay. When using CarPlay, there is no need to pair your iPhone, the USB cable connected through the USB Port (1) will enable this feature.

If other devices that are connected via Bluetooth, will be disconnected while using CarPlay.

#### **Android Auto**

Android Auto is a smarter, safer way to use your Phone in the car. Android Auto takes the things you want to do with your Phone while driving and puts them right on your car's built-in display.

You can get directions, make calls, send, and receive messages, and listen to audiobooks and music, all in a way that allows you to stay focused on the road.

NOTE: Android Auto usage is limited while driving. Functions, content, and usability is determined by the App provider(s).

Controls will vary with each App that is available for Android Auto. For

To complete the setup properly, the Parking Brake status wire must be connected.

#### How to enter Android Auto mode

For Android 9.0 or earlier, download and install the Android Auto app from Google Play.

For smartphone with Android 10.0 or later, plug in your phone and follow the prompts on your phone to accept the permissions that Android Auto requires.

Minimum Requirement: Android 6.0

#### **Connect via Bluetooth**

Establish Bluetooth connection between the car unit and your Google phone (refer to the previous chapter "Bluetooth mode"). Agree with the terms provided by Google. Please turn off the Wi-Fi function in the settings menu of the car unit before connecting your phone via Bluetooth.



During the first start up and setup of the Android Auto app, the Maps, Music, Google App will install/update automatically.

#### **Android Auto Permissions**

Several features can be allowed or denied access to customize your usability of the product.

The access can always be modified in the Setting on the Android device.

### Tuner mode

On the Home menu page touch "Tuner". The following will appear-



- 1. Access the list for stored FM, AM, or favourite stations.
- 2. Tune to a station or select a stored station.
- 3. Switch between FM and AM.
- 4. Adjust radio frequency in steps.
- 5. Switch between Stereo and Mono FM.
- 6. Set/remove the current station as favourite.
- 7. Switch FM reception between local (LOC) and distant (DX).
- 8. Access radio setting menu.
- 9. Search and store FM or AM stations.
- 10. Touch the station frequency to access the favourite stations list.
- 11. Return to the Home Menu screen.

#### **Tune to a Radio Station**

Touch and hold  $\bowtie (2)$ , The unit automatically tunes to a station with strong reception. Touch < > (4) to adjust frequency step by step.

### **Store Radio Stations Automatically**

Touch  $\mathfrak{Q}(9)$  to perform station search. All available stations in FM or AM are stored.

#### **Select a Stored Station**

Touch briefly  $\bowtie \bowtie$  (2) to select a stored station.

Or touch  $\equiv$  (1) to access the stored station list.

#### **Set or Remove Favorite Stations**

Touch  $\checkmark$  (6) to set the current station as a favourite.

To remove a station from favourite status, touch (6).

#### **Access Favorite Stations List**

Touch the radio frequency (10) E.g., 87.50

#### **Select Frequency Band**

Touch FM/AM (3)

#### Switch between Stereo or Mono FM

Touch **OO** (5)

#### Switch between Local and Distant FM

In FM band, touch (1) (7)

Select **LOC** for local reception. Only strong FM stations will be received.

Select **DX** when signals are week. This is ideal in country regions when it can be difficult to find stations.



NOTE: If tuning does not suit your region go to settings (8)  $\rightarrow$  Region  $\rightarrow$ 

"Europe" (and Australia) for FM (50 KHz), AM (9 KHz) spacing.

"USA 1" for FM (100 KHz), AM (10 KHz) spacing.

"USA 2" for FM (200 KHz), AM (10 KHz) spacing.

### RDS/RBDS

The unit has RDS/RBDS function which enables FM stations to send additional information (i.e., station name, program type and other messages) when broadcasting radio.

#### TA (Traffic Announcement)

When enabled, the unit will automatically tune in to traffic information broadcast while receiving FM broadcasts or playing media.

Once the traffic announcement ends, the original source will automatically resume.

#### AF (Alternative Frequency)

When enabled, the unit will automatically locate the same tuning program on other stations and select the strongest signal of those being broadcast.

This feature is most useful on long trips when your car goes out of the range of a radio station.

See settings  $\rightarrow$  Radio  $\rightarrow$  to select-

RDS/RBDS: On/Off

TA: On/Off

AF: On/Off

### **Registering Bluetooth devices**

The Bluetooth® function allows pairing of mobile phones and BT media playback devices with the car sound system.

When you pair a mobile phone with the car sound system, you can make phone calls with the built-in hands-free function. You can access the lists of dialed numbers and the phone book of the registered cell phone.

If the connected Bluetooth® device supports the functions A2DP and AVRCP, you can play the music via the car sound system and control the playback. During a call, the music playback is interrupted and continued again after the call.

If a mobile phone is registered via Bluetooth® and a call is received during the playback of another source, the source playback is interrupted, and the call menu is displayed.

NOTE: CarPlay or Android Auto must not be active. If being used, disconnect the device to start Bluetooth.

Compatibility with all mobile devices is not guaranteed. Please read through the user guide of the mobile device.

CAUTION: For your safety, the setup process should be accomplished while the vehicle is parked, and parking brake engaged.

In the main menu, touch Settings  $\to$  Bluetooth  $\to$  Connection to ON position  $\to$  Auto connect to ON position.

On the device that you would like to pair with, turn on Bluetooth mode. Seach for nearby devices and select "ELITE". Confirm on your device if prompted.

The unit will automatically display a code and prompt you to "YES" connect or "NO" reject the pairing  $\rightarrow$  touch "YES".


Once pairing is successful, go to Home menu and touch "BT Audio" or "Phone".

Depending on your device, music from your connected device will start to play-Alternatively touch "Phone" on the Home menu to take you to the Phone menu. See Phone mode page.



### Phone mode

See "Registering Bluetooth devices" if your device has not been paired to this unit. In the main menu, touch "Phone" and the following will appear-



Depending on your paired device, call history and contacts will automatically be visible when selected.

If not, touch "History"  $\rightarrow$  Download and "Contact"  $\rightarrow$  Download.

To see all paired devices touch "Device" and a list will appear.

To delete a paired device, touch the Bin icon next to the paired phone.

#### **Device Status**

Battery and signal strength is displayed on the top right of the screen.




NOTE: GATT Profile support is required on the mobile device.

#### **Making & Receiving Calls**


From the keypad, dial the desired number and touch . 1.



- 2. From the contacts list, touch the chosen name.
- 3. From the history list, touch the chosen name.



To End a call Touch




To use the dial pad while on a call, touch



In history mode: Swipe up or down to search

- Outgoing calls
- 2. Incoming calls
- 3. Missed calls.

In private mode: when a call needs to be transferred to the mobile device touch \* to switch to the mobile device and to return to handsfree mode.



In contacts mode: touch then enter the name → NOTE: Contacts need to be downloaded first.

#### **BT / Phone Settings**



From the Home menu, touch "Settings"  $\rightarrow$  "Bluetooth" to access the following options-

#### Voice Assistant (Push-to-talk)

You can access smartphone voice assistant through the unit.

- Enable Bluetooth connection between your smartphone and the unit or enable Apple CarPlay/Android Auto.
- Make sure the supplied hands-free microphone is connected to the Microphone Input of the unit for audio input.

Simply touch  $\P$  on the front panel to activate voice assistant, then speak your command.

#### **Twin Bluetooth Connection**

Two devices can be paired and connected simultaneously. Only one device at a time can be connected as a media player. However, both devices can be connected to make and receive calls

#### Steps

- 1. Pair each device as explained in the Bluetooth Mode instructions.
- 2. Both devices will show the phone **(** icon as blue, indicating that they are connected to make or receive calls.
- 4. To change which device is selected for media playing:
- a. Tap the media icon next to the device.
- b. Tap "Yes" for the question: "Do you need to connect Bluetooth?"
- c. The media icon 🎝 will turn blue, and that device will now be able to play media.
- 5. If either device is used to make or receive calls, it will override the current source. When the call ends, the previous source will be selected.

<sup>&</sup>quot;Auto Connect" to automatically connect to your BT device.



<sup>&</sup>quot;Device Name" – ELITE for searching and pairing this unit on your BT device.

<sup>&</sup>quot;Clear Records" to delete all paired devices.

### **Bluetooth Audio mode**

See "Registering Bluetooth devices" if your device has not been paired to this unit. In the main menu, touch "BT Audio" and the following will appear-



The music will automatically play.

Touch ▷ || to Play or Pause audio.

Touch  $| \underline{\triangleleft} | \triangleright |$  to skip to the next track or previous track. Alternatively swipe back or forwards  $\underline{\bullet}$ .

Touch and available sources from BT Audio and USB (if inserted) will display.

When playing media, the track information: song title, artist name and album will be displayed.

NOTE: For best performance, your mobile device volume should be set to maximum.

All volume adjustments for the system should be controlled from the product.

The unit will recall the last volume setting on your mobile device every time bluetooth connection is made.

Playback is supported from the mobile device with any format it can play.

Audio will only be played by the product; Video cannot be viewed on the unit.

### **USB** playback

If a USB data carrier has been inserted into the USB port marked "USB/CHARGING"- In the main menu, touch "USB" and the following will appear-




The music will automatically play.

Touch ▷ I to Play or Pause audio.

Touch and available sources from BT Audio and USB will display.

Touch to select; Repeat All, touch again for Repeat one track, or touch again for random playback.

When playing music, the track information: song title, artist name and album will be displayed.



Select which file you prefer to play-



To browse content swipe up or down

To return to the current file playing touch Playing

Supported formats:

AUDIO: FLAC, MP3, WMA

VIDEO: AVI, FLV, MKV, MOV, WMV

IMAGES: BMP, JPEG, PNG

NOTE: Watching videos or photos while driving is against Federal, State, and Local laws.

Video and or photos cannot be viewed while DRIVING. The vehicle must be stationary, and the parking brake applied to enable viewing.

We cannot guarantee the flawless function of all USB data carriers available on the market.

Turn off the unit before removing the USB data carrier.

### **Media Player mode**


In the main menu, touch "Media Player" as a quick way to enter BT Audio and USB modes. All functions are as indicated in their relative sections above.

### **AUX** mode

In the main menu, touch "AUX" to listen and/or view what is being played by the connected device.

NOTE: All controls will be made from the connected device.

### **SoundSettings**



In the main menu select touch OR touch Settings → Audio for the following parameters-Balance/Fader



Touch – or + for your desired audio focus position.

Alternatively Swipe for quick adjustment or \$\int\_{\text{.}}\$

#### Subwoofer

#### **Subwoofer Filter**

Use this to filter out higher frequencies that your subwoofer/s are not designed to operate effectively at. This will (if desired) filter out vocals improve the low frequency performance. Select the most suitable frequency cut point to suit your connected equipment.

Available filter points- 20/30/40/50/60/80/150Hz

NOTE: Audio specialists will be best to advise and tune appropriately.

#### Subwoofer Level

Adjust the Subwoofer Level (Volume) by swiping the bar

#### **High Pass Filter**


Use this to filter out low frequencies that your speakers are not designed to operate effectively at. This will prolong the life of your speakers and improve their performance.

Select the most suitable frequency cut point to suit your connected equipment.

Available filter points-50/80/120/150Hz.


NOTE: Audio specialists will be best to advise and tune appropriately.

#### Equalizer



Use the equalizer to compensate for over emphasized frequency points or deficiencies in specific frequencies.

NOTE: It is always better to lower rather than increase the frequencies to improve the above situations as it will reduce the chance of introducing distortion at the amplified stage of the signal path.



#### **Time Alignment**



Allows you to precisely adjust the time that each speaker/subwoofer is heard. Audio will be more focused and linear at the desired listening point.

#### Loudness

Activate to enhance low and high frequencies that are difficult to hear at low volume levels.

#### **Internal Amp**

To turn ON if using the internal amplifier.

Turn OFF if external amplifiers are only used. This will reduce the possibility of noise entering the signal chain when using only the pre-amp outputs.

NOTE: If a combination of internal and external amplifiers are being used; select ON.

### **Clipping Detection**

Turn ON to activate detection of distortion.

The audio level will be limited when distortion over 2% is detected.


This ensures that that the enjoyed audio experience is not negatively affected by distortion and also limits the chance of speakers being damaged.

#### Source Level

Adjust the volume of each source independently. (e.g., Radio, USB, BT Audio, AV Input, Apple CarPlay, and Android Auto).

If the volume level is too high or low when switching between sources, this setting can be used to balance the volume of each source.

### **Camera Input**



#### **Front Camera Power**

This device features front and rear camera inputs. Activate the power to the front camera in the setting menu if required.

#### Rear/Front Camera Mirror

If activated, the camera image shown on the screen is mirrored. Set as desired.


### **Parking Assist Guide**

Activate this feature if you prefer to see the parking guidelines.

NOTE: The guidelines are static.

Some cameras have their own built-in guidelines.

### **Parking Assist Guide Adjust**



Touch and drag a square icon to reposition the related guideline. Repeatedly touch an arrow icon to fine tune positioning of the related guideline.

Touch the OK icon to confirm the adjustment. To reset to the default positioning of the guidelines, touch the Reset icon.

### **Rear View Delay**

0 Sec (Default), 0.1 Sec, 0.5 Sec, 1 Sec, 2 Sec.


When switching from Park to Drive, or vice versa, the camera should not trigger on the display. Sensitivity should be adjusted to trigger only on reverse gear selector.

NOTE: Once installation and the above settings have been completed-

 $\label{thm:connected} If a rear camera is connected, the image is displayed on the screen when the rear gear is engaged.$ 


From the Home menu, touch "Camera" to see connected camera/s.





WARNING- Do not rely solely on the camera when reversing. Always be alert to your surroundings.

### **General Settings**



### Language

Touch to select English (Default), Spanish.

NOTE: CarPlay and Android Auto are independent to this setting.

#### **Time Zone**

Adjust to your local time zone.

#### **Date & Time**

Select 12 or /24 Hour Mode Adjust the time and date.

### **Daylight Savings Time**

Select ON or OFF. Set time will adjust 1 hour forward or back.

### **System Tone**

Turns ON or OFF the key press audio.

### **SWC (Steering wheel control)**

Select SWC in the Settings menu to enter SWC setting menu.



Steering Wheel Controls (SWC) allows you to operate this unit via the buttons on your steering wheel.

A third-party SWC adapter must be used if your vehicle uses a CANBUS interface for SWC, which should be configured to either "Self-Learn" or "Learning".

This unit has two SWC wires (brown & brown/black) which are located on the supplied wiring harness. Connect the two SWC wires in the OEM wiring or the third party SWC adapter.

If the OEM wiring or third party SWC adapter include a SWC ground wire, connect this wire to ground.

The following controls are available-Volume + Volume -

Call

Hang up.

Next

Previous

Voice assistant

Play/Pause

Mode

Mute

Select on the display a function and then press the corresponding function on the steering wheel.

Then repeat for all other available functions. Touch "Save/Exit" when finished.

NOTE: Note: the steering wheel or third-party adapter may not support all these functions

#### **Power Off Delay**

Some vehicles will interrupt the accessory power while the engine is starting.

If the unit re-boots while the engine is starting, turn this setting on.

The delay can be set to either 1, 2 or 3 seconds.

NOTE: Power Delay **ON** will also delay when the vehicle is turned OFF.

This might affect handsfree functionality during a call.

### **Right Hand Drive**

Set the Apple Car Play and Android Auto screen layout to suit right hand drive vehicles.

### **Factory Settings**

Select "OK" if you want to reset all functions to the factory default modes.

NOTE: All settings and presets will be lost.

### **Display**



#### **SCREEN**

#### **Illumination Control**

Touch ON so that when the vehicle lights are turned on, the screen brightness and panel button lights will automatically dim.

Touch OFF to de-activate this feature.

NOTE: To enable night detection and auto dimming, make sure the illumination input wire from the supplied wire harness is connected to your vehicle's parking light.

### Gamma Day/Night

Swipe to adjust the black level for better visibility.

### **Day/Night Brightness**

Swipe to adjust the screen brightness level for better visibility.

#### **LED**



#### **Button Colour**

Six preset colours can be chosen for the touch buttons.

To select a preset colour, make sure Multi Colour Mode feature is turned off.

#### **Multi Colour Mode**

Will cycle through all colours on the touch buttons.

Default setting is ON.

#### **UI SETTINGS**


#### Wallpaper


Change the wallpaper for the home, radio, or media playback screens from the choices available.

#### **Background Brightness**

Swipe to adjust the background brightness.

### **Connection diagram**







NOTE: Only use 2-8  $\Omega$  speakers. Do not bridge any of the channels. If the speaker outputs are not being used, go to Settings  $\rightarrow$  Audio $\rightarrow$  set Internal Amp to OFF.


A separate interface might be needed for your vehicle.

For Android Auto setup, the parking brake wire MUST be connected.

Video and or photos cannot be viewed while driving. The vehicle must be stationary, and the parking brake applied to enable viewing.

Every vehicle has a different type of parking brake connection; consult a certified professional installer.


Always insulate wires that are not being used.



(Front/rear speaker outputs and two subwoofer outputs)


NOTE: If the speaker outputs are not being used, go to Settings  $\rightarrow$  Audio $\rightarrow$  set Internal Amp to OFF.

Subwoofer Pre-amp is non-fading. Always use double shielded RCA leads and run away from any power cables to reduce the possibility or noise.



NOTE: Never rely solely on the rear-view camera; always check your surroundings before proceeding.

#### Handsfree Mic placement-



The RED areas are recommended for the best microphone performance.

Do not place the microphone in front of or near air vents.

The front of the microphone must not be obstructed.

The Microphone should be secured.

NOTE: Run the microphone wire where it will not interfere with the safe operation of the vehicle.
